RESOLUTION: Government is pleased to sanction under sub-  
section (2) of section 15 of the Bombay Khar Lands Act, 1948, the  
Kora Kendra Khar lands Scheme for the development of khar lands  
in the villages of \* , taluka Borivli, District Thana.

The requisite notification should be published in the Bombay  
Government Gazette.

2. The Collector of Thana should be requested to arrange  
for the publication of the scheme under sub-section (3) of the  
said section 15, in the village and at the taluka and district  
headquarters concerned.

3. The expenditure of Rs. 69,188/8/- on account of Government  
contribution of 40 per cent of the total cost of the scheme, and  
60% in respect of Government Lands should be debited to "7-Land  
Revenue-D-Development Schemes - Second Five Year Plan-D-1(4)  
Reclamation of Khar and Khajan Lands Grain-in-aid and subsidy  
payable by Government" and should be met from the provision made  
thereunder during the current year. This amount of expenditure  
should be paid to the Board in accordance with the procedure laid  
down in Government Resolution, No. KLD. 1056-H(Bud) dated the 7th  
July 1956.
